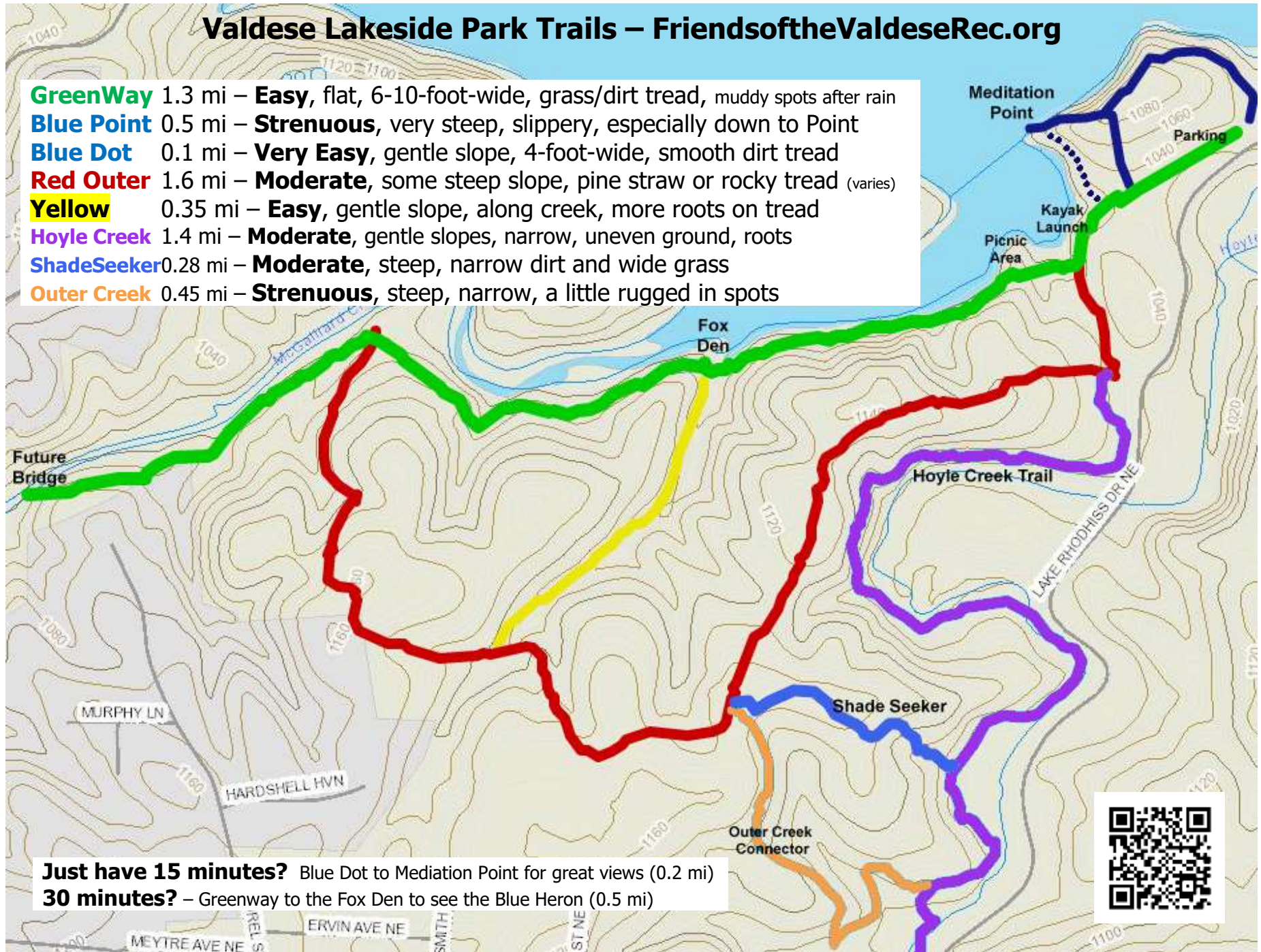


Valdese Lakeside Park Trails – FriendsOftheValdeseRec.org

- GreenWay** 1.3 mi – **Easy**, flat, 6-10-foot-wide, grass/dirt tread, muddy spots after rain
- Blue Point** 0.5 mi – **Strenuous**, very steep, slippery, especially down to Point
- Blue Dot** 0.1 mi – **Very Easy**, gentle slope, 4-foot-wide, smooth dirt tread
- Red Outer** 1.6 mi – **Moderate**, some steep slope, pine straw or rocky tread (varies)
- Yellow** 0.35 mi – **Easy**, gentle slope, along creek, more roots on tread
- Hoyle Creek** 1.4 mi – **Moderate**, gentle slopes, narrow, uneven ground, roots
- ShadeSeeker** 0.28 mi – **Moderate**, steep, narrow dirt and wide grass
- Outer Creek** 0.45 mi – **Strenuous**, steep, narrow, a little rugged in spots



Just have 15 minutes? Blue Dot to Mediation Point for great views (0.2 mi)
30 minutes? – Greenway to the Fox Den to see the Blue Heron (0.5 mi)
